HOW WE CAN HELP....

Downpayment - Closing Costs

May provide funding equal to 10% of purchase price to assist with lender required downpayment and/or closing costs.

1:1 match requirement -additional affordable housing
funding may be identified and/or
provided by the Program
Administrator to fulfill match
requirement.

Property must meet program condition standards at time of purchase -- additional rehabilitation funding may be available to resolve property condition issues immediately post purchase.



HOME REHABILITATION ASSISTANCE

HOW WE CAN HELP....

Allowable Improvements may include, but are not limited to:

- Roof, Siding, Door, Stair repair/replacement
- Plumbing and Electrical repair/upgrade
- Energy Efficiency Improvements—may include window replacement
- Well and Septic repair/replacement
- Accessibility improvements/modifications
- Lead Paint remediation

The Assisted Property must be Owned and Occupied by the applicant household
